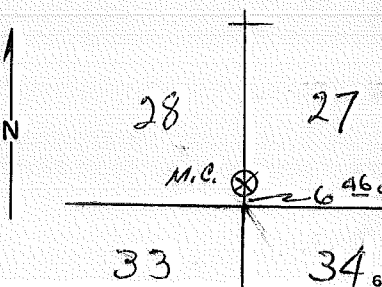

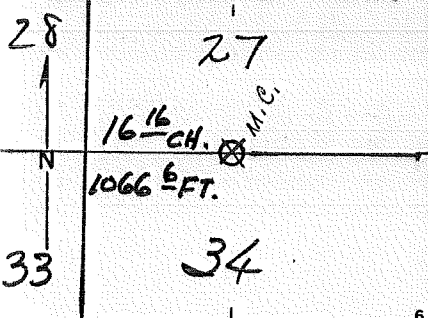

An 8" White Fir bears S31°00'W at 20.8 ft., marked T11SRI@EMCBT.

A Brass Washer marked LS 2111 was installed between the B and T of the scribe. Distances were measured to the side-center of the root crown.

Additional Monument description: The monument is rising 15" above ground and I added a rock mound to help support the monument.
